John Swan

1891 census: living in Whitehill, Kirkmahoe as boarder. Formerly a sawyer.

1892: death certificate. Pauper, formerly sawyer. Parents names from death certificate. Informant: son, Robert.

Agness Hunter

1841 census: Kirkton, Kirkmahoe. Agness Hunter, head of household with children.

1851 census: Kirkston, Kirkmahoe. In household: John and Agness, Janet, Jean, RObert, James, William (visitor), Agnes (daughter-in-law), Margaret (granddaughter). Also Charles and John Brown, grandsons.

1861 census: Kirkton, Kirkmahoe with grandsons, John and Charles Swan.

1871 census: No 16, Kirton, Kirkmahoe. Great great grandson, Charles Swan living with them.

1881 census: No 17 Kirkton Village, Kirkmahoe. Charles Swan, great great grandson, age 13, born in Kirkcowan, Wigtonshire, living with John and Agnes

John Swan

Death certificate indicates he had fathered three children, the first two died in infancy (can't read names).

Cause of death: typhus, also had TB.

1851 census: living in Kirkmahoe. Occupation: sawyer.

William Robson Swan

Monument in Kirkmahoe Parish Churchyard. Monument mentions William, John, James, and Jane Thornburn, wife of Robert.

Notes: (con't)

James Swan

Died in infancy. Buried Kirkmahoe Parish Churchyard, DUmfriesshire.

Robert Swan

1884: informant on mother's death certificate. Living in Carsnoloch (sp?)
