Tregantle SS was a 3,091grt, British Merchant steamer. On the 22nd April 1916 when 1½ miles ESE from Corton Light Vessel, Suffolk, she was torpedoed by German submarine U-16. Vessel was beached but declared a total loss. Owned by E. Hain & Son, St. Ives.

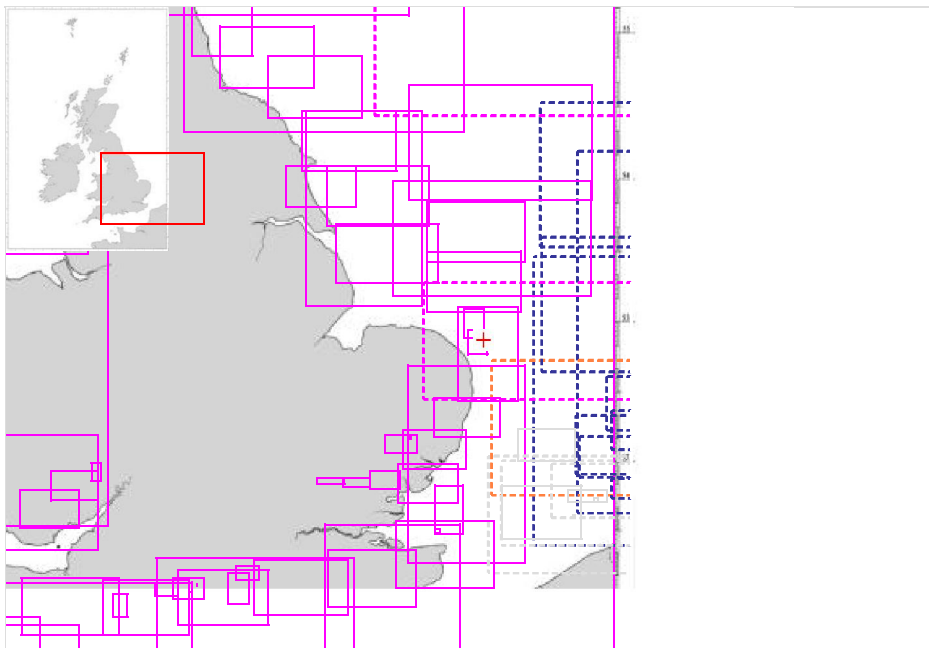

In 1972 the company was merged into P&O's General Cargo Divison. The company ships started with the Cornish title Tre. Before 1938, the flag showed ...
